## Winter Project

The CHC is currently undertaking a Winter Project to obtain meaningful feedback from patients during the 'winter pressure' months and to allow the Health Board to respond proactively to any issues which may arise. The project will run from January 2019 until March 2019. To date, members have obtained feedback from some 394 patients!

Below are some of the key themes identified:

- Long waits in an ambulance
- Long waits on a trolley
- Seating not comfortable
- Lack of space
- Staff excellent, always busy
- Doctors and nurses very kind
- Poor communication
- Good feedback regarding privacy and dignity
- Good feedback regarding availability of refreshments

### **Homeless Project**

The CHC will be commencing a homeless project within the coming weeks. The project will enable any person who is rough sleeping, homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, the opportunity to give feedback on their experience of healthcare; including barriers to accessing services, as well as what the service is like when accessed.
