## To consider Planning Applications submitted for Council's observations

C/2021/0329: Construction of 3 new detached dwellings served by new shared driveway with parking provision for 2 cars on each plot and including landscaping and services as well as off site highway improvement works, land adjoining Park Hill, Park Hill, Tredegar.

**Observations:** Council objects on highway grounds; Inkerman Terrace adjoins a narrow strip of land and this could cause highway issues, with the loss of the turning area currently in place. Members could not envisage a viable solution that would work in respect of congestion and highway issues. There was also a possible issue in respect of over-development.

C/2021/0334: Conversion / refurbishment improvement and alterations of the existing community hall to accommodate a new independent living unit, Community Centre, Bill Harry Court, Charles Street.

Observations: No objections.

C/2021/0336: Demolition of lean-to garage and new double storey pitched roof extension to side with lean-to porch to front, 53 Golwg-y-Mynydd.

No objections.

C/2021/0343: Retention of bungalow as built, Plot 2 rear of Queen Victoria Street.

No objections.

C/2021/0348: Single storey side extension, 23 Bush Bach.

No objections.

C/2021/0350: Construction of two pods to create a co-working office hub, Bryn Bach Country Park, Merthyr Road.

No objections.

C/2021/0358: Application for prior notification of proposed demolition for a twostorey building 23 and 24 Stocktonville, property no longer complies with appropriate residential standards.

**Observations:** Members expressed concern that, should demolishing properties be more cost-effective that raising the premises to standard, this could set a precedent for the future, particularly as there were properties of similar construction throughout Tredegar. A Member said that, as a point of clarity, he understood the reason for demolition related to unstable ground conditions rather than construction.

Members agreed that greater clarification was needed as, if the need for demolition related to unstable ground, how would this affect other properties in the vicinity
