P/2026/0136	Mr. R. Baron Larboratree Ltd. 6 Twyn Place Newport	To undertake works to protected trees in line with the attached tree survey. The protected trees we are aware of are T008 (T1 BG5 yew), T004 Ash, T005 Ash, T006 Sycamore covered by BG5 G2 and G002 Covered by BG5 G1. The exception is T008 (T1 BG5) due to its proximity to the property the client has requested the trees be felled. The Fountain Inn, Troedrhiwgwair.
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Observations:

Council noted the building was 'listed'; a Member said she was strongly opposed to any works being undertaken to the trees. The Chair thereupon outlined the proposed works, i.e. Ash – dieback, Sycamore – diseased, coppicing of remaining [Hazel], whereupon Members expressed serious concern with regard to proposed works to the yew tree being reduced by 3m and pruned to achieve a 3m clearance from the building, stating the tree was not aesthetically pleasing. Council emphasised the great significance of this yew tree and were therefore strongly opposed to the works proposed within the application.

Councillor G. Badham declared an interest in the following application and took no part in the decision-making or voting thereon

P/2026/0166	Mr. Cooke Tai Calon Community Housing Solis One Griffin Lane Rising Sun Industrial Estate Blaina	Residential development and associated works, Land at Waundeg, Tredegar.
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Observations

Council received feedback from the local Ward Members, who relayed comments of residents within the area in respect of observations relating to the proposed development, but took no part in decision-making or voting thereon, i.e.

The residents were opposed to the proposed planning development and were protective of the green area; the houses were of old Cornish stock – this was a close knit community and residents were conscious of who would be housed in single occupancy properties; Tai Calon had provided 'open

days' and gathered a lot of information. However, it was noted there was sufficient parking available in the area and a Member said she recognised this type of housing. was in demand.

Council therefore **objected** on the grounds of loss of amenity of the children's play area [green space], housing of undesirous individuals, and that remedial works were required to existing properties in a deplorable condition before building new. Therefore Council asked of the intention of Tai Calon Community Housing in respect of any proposals for the two properties situated in the circle area.
